Quantitative research Quantitative ('quant') research is used to quantify the problem by way of generating numerical data that can be transformed into useable statistics. It is used to quantify attitudes, opinions, behaviors, and other defined variables, and generalize results from a larger sample population.

The difference between qualitative and quantitative research

Quantitative Research uses measurable data to formulate facts and uncover patterns in research. Quantitative data collection methods are much more structured than Qualitative data collection methods. Quantitative data collection methods include various forms of surveys - online surveys, paper surveys, mobile surveys and kiosk surveys, face-to-face interviews, telephone interviews, longitudinal studies, website interceptors, online polls, and systematic observations.

Qualitative research is the process of collecting and analyzing data which is nonnumerical, such as language. Qualitative data can be collected using diary accounts or in-depth interviews, and analyzed using grounded theory or thematic analysis.

Qualitative vs Quantitative Research | Simply Psychology

Quantitative studies generally involve the systematic collection of data about a phenomenon, using standardized measures and statistical analysis. In contrast, qualitative studies involve the systematic collection, organization, description and interpretation of textual, verbal or visual data.

The primary aim of a Qualitative Research is to provide a complete, detailed description of the research topic. It is usually more exploratory in nature. Quantitative and Qualitative Research — Objective of ...

Qualitative research is one which provides insights and understanding of the problem setting.
